### School

**1 Standard 20 lessons per week**

Share the daily lifestyle and experiences of a British home. This is an excellent choice to avail of the opportunity of getting to know their culture and practise English in a comfortable and friendly atmosphere.

All host families are thoroughly interviewed and regularly inspected by the accommodation department of the school. The most important thing for the student is to know that by choosing this option the student is sharing the home and hospitality of a family.

Host families aren't necessarily traditional, they can be homes with an only member, however they all have something in common they are friendly and are happy to welcome students.

Students must remember that host families are not hotels, one has to be nice to them. For instance, you can tidy your room and if you foresee you are going to be late for dinner you can call home and let them know.
